2009 ITTF Certified National Referee Course

The first ITTF Certified National Referee Course/Examination 2009 will be conducted on 17 - 19 December 2009 in Majlis Sukan Negara, Bukit Jalil, Kuala Lumpur. All State Table Tennis Associations are invited to nominate two international umpires who have the knowledge and experience in both umpiring and organizing tournament to attend the above course. The Course instructors are Mr. Cyril Sen and Mr. Tan Kheng Hong. All nominations must reach TTAM before 15 November 2009.

ITTF Level 2 Coaching Course in Kuala Lumpur

On 9-14 November 2009, the ITTF Course Instructor, Mr. Philippe Molodtsov from France will be conducting the 2009 ITTF Level 2 Coaching Course in Olympic Hotel, Kuala Lumpur. The eligible candidates are coaches who possess ITTF Level 1 Certificates nominated by TTAM or the State Associations. The registration fee is RM100 per person and all other expenses will be borne by the participants.



Singapore 2010 Friendship Camp

The Olympic Council of Malaysia has selected Liew Yong Xuan (Perak) as the female candidate to represent Malaysia to participate in the Singapore 2010 Friendship Camp which will be held at the Singapore Sports School from 8-12 December 2009. The Singapore 2010 Friendship Camp is organized by the Singapore Ministry of Education, the Singapore Youth Olympic Games Organising Committee and the Singapore Sports School.

The Camp is open to candidates aged 15-17 years old and each National Olympic Council has been invited to nominate one male and one female candidate for the Camp.

OCM invited all national sports associations to nominate one male and one female candidate for selection and the selection is based on 3 main criteria :

1. Sports History
2. Conversation ability in English and French
3. Personality – Independent, out-going, mature.

TTAM nominated Goh Nai Ngee (KL) and Liew Yong Xuan (Perak). The male candidate selected came from Football Association of Malaysia.



Diana to attend Study Tour Project in Japan



The Olympic Council of Malaysia has selected Madam Nur Asmara Diana Thong Abdullah from the Table Tennis Association of Malaysia and one other person from another Sports Association to attend the Study Tour Project for Leaders of Asian Youth Sports 2009 to be held in Tokyo, Japan from 4th to 11th November 2009. Diana is an International Umpire from Kuala Lumpur who has served as an umpire in various international and local table tennis events.
